Happy Holidays to all our clients and prospective clients. This is a busy time of the year to take care of our family yet, some

of the little responsibilities to our communities are overlooked. There is rain on the way. We have already seen two consistent rain days here in San Diego, each with heavy downpours. We are currently cleaning all drainage and cement drain swales throughout all our properties. As you read this Newsletter we are installing new drainage on some of our older properties. During the last downpour we had calls of drains clogging up. It is important at this time of the year to remove all leaves and debris from or near the drains, not just on a weekly basis but especially right before the rain. All our Supervisors are checking the drains daily and/or instructing our on site crew members to do the same. If you see any drainage issue or concerns, please contact our Office.

Erosion and run off of soil is another concern at this time of year. All dirt or bare areas on any slope need to be planted immediately. It is never too late to plant in Southern California. If you have any erosion concerns, please contact us.

On November 30, 2007 it rained 2

inches or more throughout San Diego County. The day before, we turned off all the irrigation on all of our properties. On December 7, it rained $\frac{3}{4}$ inch throughout San Diego County. The irrigation on all of our properties was turned off still on November 7 and is turned off as of today's date. The weather is cold and there is now frost throughout the I-15 corridor and San Diego County. Keep your irrigation off. If you have any irrigation concerns, please contact us. All of the communities managed by Western Gardens will continue to have the irrigation shut off until further notice. We are expecting our next rain within 10 days and it should be consistent throughout the next 3 months.

If you have not received your \$5,000 rebate for irrigation upgrades through the Smart Landscape Program with the San Diego County Water Authority, we need to act promptly. The program is over on March 22, 2008.

You may spend up to \$5,000 on any type of irrigation material. The San Diego County Water Authority Smart Landscape Program will send a rebate check to you up to \$5,000 on the amount of irrigation material you will spend to upgrade your irrigation system.

The San Diego County Water Authority believes the \$5,000 rebate will create an incentive for all residents of San Diego County to replace old irrigation heads, nozzles, pipe, valves, and especially irrigation controllers with the new ET 30% water saving controllers.

Spend \$5,000 in new irrigation materials and receive a check for \$5,000. It is a simple program.

Please e-mail our office if you are not yet involved in this program, there is \$5,000 waiting for you!

There is a lot of tree work being generated through our Office right now. If you are not trimming trees yet, or if you have any questionable trees that have not been addressed, please contact our Office.
